Music Scholarship Audition Dates for 2020-21

Students are strongly advised to audition in person on one of the above dates. If this is not possible due to geographical distance or extenuating circumstances, applicants may contact the Music Department to request approval to submit auditions by video recording (with high quality audio). Students are asked to seek approval and complete the submission process no later than Friday, March 12. In addition to a video, an on-campus interview/audition may be required before a scholarship offer can be made. Please contact the Music Department if you seek further information.

Audition Requirements

SINGERS

Prepare two contrasting pieces; one must be in a language other than English. An accompanist can be provided, or you may bring your own (no pre-recorded accompaniments). Memorization is preferred.

PIANISTS

Prepare two contrasting selections or single movements of larger works. Memorization is preferred.

ORGANISTS

Prepare two contrasting pieces (memorization is optional)

ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTALISTS

Prepare two contrasting pieces (memorization is optional). An accompanist can be provided, or you may bring your own (no pre-recorded accompaniments).

ACCOMPANISTS

If you require Erskine to provide an accompanist for your audition, you must send a copy of your music at least two weeks in advance of the scheduled audition date.
