



ERSKINE COLLEGE RETURN TO CAMPUS PLAN

SPRING SEMESTER 2021

Erskine's plan for a successful reopening consists of three parts: **Plan, Care, and Respond**. Here is a brief summary of guidelines:

PLAN

Preparation: Before moving back onto campus, prepare yourself and the materials you will need:

- Get tested if you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or think you may have been exposed.
- Bring a washable mask or face covering to campus. This is required.
- Bring cleaning supplies for personal use. Public areas will be cleaned daily.

Move-In Procedures

When you move back to campus, please follow these important guidelines:

- Arrive during your scheduled move-in time with no more than two guests.
- Wear face coverings throughout your move (both you and your guests).

CARE (Community, Academics, Residence Life, Events)

Community

- We will increase cleaning in public areas and provide sanitizer stations.
- Clean personal spaces and items and avoid sharing personal items.
- Practice physical distancing and mask-wearing.

Academics

- The Spring 2021 Academic Calendar has been altered as previously communicated.
- We will match classroom sizes with course enrollment to maximize physical distancing.
- Face coverings must be worn in all buildings and classrooms.

Residence Life

- Follow posted directions and other signage concerning proper distancing and hygiene.
- Wear face coverings in common areas and practice physical distancing.
- Dining areas will be open at reduced capacity with no self-service lines.
- Take-out options available.

Events

- Some nonessential activities may be suspended.
- Students will be assigned chapel times to attend on either Tuesdays or Thursdays.
- Several "passive" convo opportunities will be made available.

RESPOND

Management of Suspected or Confirmed Cases of COVID-19

- Students who test positive must return home. If unable to do so, they will be placed in isolation.
- Students identified as a "close contact" through the contact tracing process will be required to quarantine per CDC guidelines.
- Quarantined students must contact their professors to arrange an academic plan.
